Sewing Notions for FCS 1

These are the needed notions for the students as they begin their sewing unit. You may buy these at most fabric or craft stores. Taylor's Hardware in town also sells the kits as well as material.

- Sewing Scissors
- Pins
- Pin Cushion
- Measuring tape
- Hand Sewing Needles
- Thimble
- Seam Gauge

Please have each of the items in the kit marked with the student's name in permanent ink.

The following items will need to be purchased for sewing their pillowcase and hat.

- 1 Spool of thread to match material
- ¾ yard of cotton or a cotton blend material
- 1/3 yard of different cotton or a cotton blend material
- 1/8 yard of a third color or pattern of cotton or a cotton blend

The different colors should match enough to be sewn together as a single pillowcase.

- 1/3 yard of fleece to make a hat with
